She has then been a member of the ensemble of the Deutsche Oper in Berlin, where she has sung, among several other roles, *Zerlina* in ***Don Giovanni***, *Frasquita* in ***Carmen***, the *Sacerdotessa* in a N/P of ***Aida*** as well as several concerts.

Adriana worked with important Conductors such as Paolo Arrivabeni, Andrea Battistoni, Diego Matheuz, Stefano Montanari, Ivan Repusic, Donald Runnicles, Alexander Vedernikov, Sebastian Weigle.

Among her recent and future engagements ***Il Viaggio a Reims*** in Rome, *Susanna* in ***Le nozze di Figaro*** in Cagliari, ***Gianni Schicchi*** in Amsterdam, *Valencienne* in ***Die lustige Witwe*** in Venice, Rome and Naples, ***Carmen*** in Berlin, ***Idomeneo*** and ***Turandot*** in Rome, ***La traviata*** in Poznan.
